

## Summer Camp Eligibility Requirements

We are an organization with a specific vision. “To be a community in Christ of servant leadership and transformation, seeking a full life for all involved; urban youth, families, volunteers, and staff in the neighborhoods of our city.”

Because of this calling, we dedicate our time and our efforts to serving children & families who live directly in the city of Wilmington. They will take priority in all of our programs as a way to pursue the calling and the responsibility that we believe God has given to us.

### Camp Enrollment

UP Camps are intended for children who live in the immediate community surrounding each camp. The communities we serve are 19801, 19802, and 19805.

### Eligibility requirements

- Must live within 19801, 19802, and 19805.
- Must be a rising 1st-6th grade camper.

### Exceptions

- A camper in the immediate family of a staff member is able to register into a UP camp. However, priority will be given to children in the neighborhoods and they will be assigned to a camp.
- If a camper is a participant of the UP school and does not live in one of the zip codes, they are eligible to enroll in an UrbanPromise camp. However, priority will be given to children in the neighborhoods and they will be assigned to a camp with a lower enrollment.
- If a family has moved out of zip code during the middle of a programming season, that child may finish out the season with that assigned camp.

### Out of Zip Code enrollments

- Children who do not meet the eligibility requirements will be put on a waiting list that is shared with directors.
- Families will be notified a week prior to the beginning of camp if and which camp their child will attend.
- Directors may or may not choose to accept out of zip code residents.
- If a director is accepting out of zip code residents, that director must reach out to the child on the waiting list to confirm their enrollment.
- If no directors are accepting out of zip code residents, all campers on the waiting list will be called and denied the ability to enroll.
  - Our policy on accepting children will be evaluated at the end of each season and is subject to change.
